14	<i>Sansevieria trifasciata</i>	Snake Plant/ Mother in law's tongue		<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Absorbs toxins such as nitrogen oxides & formaldehyde
15	<i>Aloe barbadensis</i>	Aloe Vera		<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Sun loving succulent helps clear formaldehyde & benzene
16	<i>Aglaonema sp</i>	Chinese Evergreen		<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Emits high oxygen & purifies indoor air 2. Removes formaldehydes, benzene
17	<i>Epipremnum aureum syn. Scindapsus aureus</i>	Golden Pothos		<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Removes formaldehyde 2. Removes Carbon monoxide and increases indoor air quality

18	<i>Dracaena marginata</i>	Marginata or Dragon tree		<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Purifies air from carcinogen, benzene 2. Removes formaldehyde, xylene from paints & varnishes

20	<i>Chrysanthemum sp. or Chrysanthemum morifolium</i>	Mums		<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Removes benzene and carcinogenic substances from air
21	<i>Gerbera sp. or Gerbera jamesonii</i>	Gerbera Daisy		<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Removes benzene 2. Absorbs Carbon dioxide and gives oxygen during night - helps in improving sleep

22	<i>Hedera helix</i>	English Ivy		<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Removes benzene, pesticides and off-gasing of other synthetic materials 2. Fantastic for Asthma & allergies 3. Removes formaldehyde
23	<i>Philodendron oxycardium</i>	Heart leaf philodendron		<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Removes all kinds of VOCs, particularly from particle board
24	<i>Ficus benjamina</i>	Weeping fig		<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Filters pullutants from carpeting, furniture
25	<i>Dracaena deremeusis</i> or <i>Dracanea deremensis warneckeii</i>	Warneckii or Dracanaena warneckeii		<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Removes trichloroethylene from the air, emitted by photocopier

26	<i>Phoenix roebelenii</i>	Pygmy date, miniature date palm		1. Removes formaldehyde, xylene and toluene
27	<i>Dracaena fragrans</i>	Corn or cornstalk plant		1. Removes benzene, formaldehyde, xylene 2. Purifies environment
28	<i>Gerbera Jamesonii</i>	Gerbera Daisy		1. Removes trichloroethylene, benzene from air
29	<i>Dracaena Marginata</i>	Dragon Tree		1. Reduces benzene, formaldehyde, xylene and toluene from air
